# What are Pre-Employment Transition Services (Pre-ETS)?

The New York City Department of Education Transition and College Access Centers (TCAC) will provide college and career readiness services identified through career assessments and activities such as training, one-to-one counseling, small group activities, and city-wide college and career fairs for students with disabilities.

Pre-ETS services focus on services that will help to prepare students with disabilities for life after high school through a variety of experiences and supports including:

- Career and college exploration
- Counseling on postsecondary pathways and programs
- Work-based learning experiences
- Workplace readiness training
- Instruction in self-advocacy

### **Program Goals**

Support students in developing independent living and career skills and postsecondary planning for life after high school.

- Implement effective strategies that increase and support independent living and inclusion in the community
- Provide education and training to develop work readiness skills
- Disseminate information to families, schools and students on innovative, effective, and efficient approaches to implement pre-employment and transition services
- Coordinate activities with transition services provided by local educational agencies and community partners
- Provide support in transition planning and services particularly for those who are traditionally underserved

## How do I know if I am Eligible for Pre-ETS?

- If you have an Individualized Educational Program (IEP), or
- If you have a Section 504 plan of the Rehabilitation Act and Americans with Disabilities Act, or
- If you have an evaluation or documented proof of disability from your healthcare provider
